of educational and professional programme  
"Architecture of Buildings and Structures"  
for the training of higher education students of the second (Master's) level  
in the specialty 191 "Architecture and Urban Planning"

The educational and professional program "Architecture of Buildings and Structures" is intended for the training of students at the second (Master's) level of higher education in the specialty 191 "Architecture and Urban Planning" and is implemented at the National University "Yuri Kondratyuk Poltava Polytechnic".

A feature of the program is the focus on training a universal specialist who is able to perform a wide range of tasks in the field of architecture and urban planning, and thus is most in demand in small architectural bureaus, in small, medium-sized cities, regional centres, where the vast majority of orders are relatively small objects with a variety of functional purposes. Attention is also paid to the formation of the programme graduates' ability to maintain and develop the national and regional identity of architectural environment, to ensure the sustainable development of settlements, which are urgent tasks for both Ukraine and the countries of the European Union (for example, within the framework of the BAUHAUS programme implementation).

The list of proposed disciplines, general and special (professional) competences and program results of training under the educational and professional program are of a practical nature, successfully combining theoretical and practical methods of forming architectural objects aimed at solving wide-ranging and complex problems in the field of architecture and urban planning. The volume of educational components and the sequence of their study (structural and logical scheme) correspond to the purpose of the educational and professional program and ensure the achievement of its results.

In the process of further improvement of the educational and professional program, I would like to advise in Major No. 1 to allocate a separate academic discipline for the study of conservation and restoration of architectural monuments, while preserving the study of the architecture of religious buildings (by separating it into a separate discipline, or including it as a separate module in the program of another discipline). Both of these issues are extremely important for the preservation and development of national culture, which is an urgent task in both Ukraine and Poland.

Taking into account the above, I believe that the educational and professional program "Architecture of Buildings and Structures" can be recommended for use at the National University "Yuri Kondratyuk Poltava Polytechnic" in the training of higher education students at the second (Master's) level in the specialty 191 "Architecture and Urban Planning".
